Community Events - FAQ



1. What is a community event?

A community event can be organized by anyone or company in an effort to raise funds for the Ontario Track 3 Ski Association. A community event can raise funds through event admission fees, donations, silent or live auctions, raffle draws - it can be as small or large as you wish it to be! Some event ideas are:

- Organize a ski day, golf tournament, or a fun baseball game with friends and family and request a donation for all those interested in playing.
- Organize a movie night at home with friends and offer ticket sales of \$5 in support of Ontario Track 3 Ski Association
- Getting married? Many couples are “going green” and, instead of offering a wedding favor, are making a donation on behalf of each guest.

2. What type of support will I receive from Ontario Track 3 Ski Association?

Depending on the size of your event, Ontario Track 3 will provide you with forms to assist you with collecting donations, answer questions, provide tips leading up to your event, supply signage and, provide literature about the organization. Depending on the timing of your event, a representative from Ontario Track 3 may be available to speak at or, attend your event.

3. Can I use the Ontario Track 3 Ski Association logo?

With approval, yes. The logo must have the words **in support of** clearly printed above it.

4. When should I send my community event registration form in by?

To ensure that we may assist you as best we can, please submit your registration form at least 4 weeks prior to your event date.

5. Is there a deadline for submitting the donations collected at my event?

For tax purposes, please submit the Donation Log and monies no later than 60 days following the event date.

6. Where will the funds be directed?

Funds raised at your event will assist Ontario Track 3 Ski Association through a number of ways. These include: purchasing adaptive equipment for the children and youth in the Track 3 program, maintaining the Ontario Track 3 buildings at various locations, providing bus transportation to volunteers and students to and from the ski hills, assist the organization with administrative costs and, most importantly: allow us to welcome more students into the program each winter (It costs approximately \$1,650 per child to participate in this very rehabilitative program) Every bit helps!!
